

## **Undeveloped Film Labels Are Now Available For Order for Express Customers**

US based customers who regularly ship undeveloped film may now order the FedEx Express Undeveloped Film labels. (part # 2041730152) This label alerts employees throughout the Express system of loading directions which will help reduce the chances of damaged package claims.

Shipments containing Radioactive Materials, a type of dangerous goods or hazardous materials are incompatible with undeveloped film and these packages must be separated from packages of undeveloped film in the Express system in order to prevent damage to the film shipments.

Customers may now call 1.800.GO.FEDEX or 1.800.463-3339 and follow these directions to order the undeveloped film labels:

- The customer should press “0” to speak with a Customer Service Representative since the Undeveloped Film label is not listed on the IVR (interactive voice response) prompt.
- They will be asked to confirm by pressing “0” again.

The customer service representative must place the order. These labels are available 250 per roll.
